THANKS TO ITS VERY CENTRAL LOCATION, ITS INFRASTRUCTURES AND SERVICES, THE REGION IS ITSELF A STRATEGIC LOGISTICAL PLATFORM IN ITALY, IN THE MEDITERRANEAN, AND IN EUROPE



2 International Airports (Fiumicino and Ciampino, over 50 million passengers per year). Fiumicino Leonardo Da Vinci Airport is the first stopover in Italy and the first European airport for

the satisfaction of travellers.



Civitavecchia Port is the major Italian touristic port, the 2nd in Europe and 7th in the world for number of passengers (3 million per year). It boasts a movement of 10 million tons of goods a year.



LAZIO

2 main railway stations (Termini and Tiburtina) which guarantee high speed rail connections with all major Italian and European cities. Lazio is part of the Trans-European Networks -Transport (TEN-T). Main Highways: A1 Milano-Roma-Napoli, A12 Roma-Civitavecchia, A24 Roma-L'Aquila. The extension of the road network in Lazio Region consists of approximately 10 thousand kilometres, of which 473 are motorways and 553 national roads.

LAZIO AT A GLANCE

Lazio is the 2nd Italian Region for Gross Domestic Product (GDP) with **198 Bn euros**, contributing to **1,.2% of Italian national GDP** (2018). It is one of the most important R&D systems in Italy.

GDP per capita is equal to € 33.600, above the Italian and the EU average. Lazio is the sixth Italian Region in terms of GDP per capita.

Lazio is the location of important industrial and multinational groups with their own R&D centres, and the Italian Region with the highest level of specialization in manufacturing and in high-tech knowledge intensive sectors.

Lazio's share of exports in global leading sectors is twice the national average (in percentage terms 72% vs 32%).

Rome, with over **20** million **tourists a year**, is the most visited city in Italy and one of the most visited in the world.

LAZIO PLAYS A SIGNIFICANT INTERNATIONAL ROLE IN THE INDUSTRY OF AEROSPACE, AERONAUTICS, SPACE ECONOMY AND SECURITY, BOTH IN THE MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY AND FOR SPECIFIC SKILLS IN TECHNOLOGICAL SERVICES AND R&D

Lazio is the only Italian Region which **hosts the whole aerospace value chain.** Important big groups of international excellence in electronics, sensors, avionics, components and innovative materials, "space" and satellite applications and services, are located in the Region.

LAZIO AEROSPACE TECHNOLOGICAL DISTRICT (DTA) was established in 2004 by a Framework Agreement signed by Italy Ministry of Research and Lazio Region. In 2012, the DTA of Lazio was one of the founding partners of the Italian National Cluster for Aerospace Technological (CTNA).

ESA BIC (Business Incubation Centre) Lazio is a partnership among Lazio Region, ASI (Italian Space Agency) and ESA (European Space Agency), and it is part of the Innovation and Ventures Office (TIA-AI).

In 2019, Lazio ranks first in Italy in terms of ICT spending with more than 20% of the national ICT expenditure.



LAZIO BOASTS AN EXTREMELY IMPORTANT AND CONSOLIDATED AUTOMOTIVE SECTOR. THE REGIONAL ENGINEERING INDUSTRY CONSISTS OF HUNDREDS OF SMEs LINKED TO THE FULL SUPPLY CHAIN, IN PARTICULAR TO COMPONENTS PRODUCTION

Particularly important is the concentration of companies of the **automotive supply chain** in the **industrial area of Cassino (Frosinone).** The development of this strategic area began in 1972 with FIAT. The site, which covers ar area of over 2 million square meters, is **the largest FCA plant in Italy**, only equal to the Mirafiori site in Turin, and represents one of the greatest employment resources for in the Region.





In 2019, Lazio region exported goods and services for 26.6 Bn euros, recording a growth of 15% compared to 2018.

Imports in 2019 increased to 36.8 Bn euros, slightly up compared to 2018 (+ 1.5%).


Lazio exports highly innovative products, i.e. pharmaceuticals, but also more traditional goods, such as agrifood products. The agrifood sector has grown

three three faster than national average in the last years.



In Lazio there are 10.618 export operators (according to the region of origin of the goods) out of a national total of over 217 thousand operators.

Lazio main trading partners are located in the European area, particularly in the Union area (EU28, 60,9% of the total, 16,2 Bn Euro). The first country where Lazio exported goods in 2019 is Belgium with 3.7 Bn Euro, followed by US with 3.5 Bn and the Germany with 3.3 Bn.





Top 10 countries where Lazio has exported goods in 2019 (values in Bn ϵ)

The main products exported from Lazio are pharmaceuticals with 12.5 Bn Euro (46,7% of the total), followed by vehicles with 3.1 Bn (12%) and Chemicals products with 1.9 Bn Euro (7%).







FDI FOREIGN AND MULTINATIONAL DIRECT INVESTMENTS

In 2017, the stock of outbound FDI (from Lazio to foreign countries) amounted to 111.4 Bn euros.

Incoming FDI (from foreign countries to Lazio) amounted to 73.6 Bn euros, the best value of the last five years and over 2 Bn euro more than 2016.
